Project Title: 2007 French Valley Airport Compatibility Plan

Project Description:

The proposed project is the adoption of the 2007 Compatibility Plan for the French Valley Airport by the Commission. French Valley Airport is located in southwestern Riverside County, adjacent to the communities of Temecula, Murrieta, and Winchester. The previous plan was the 2004 French Valley Airport Land Use Compatibility Plan ("2004 Compatibility Plan"). The Commission has elected to abandon the prior 2004 Compatibility Plan, and to consider adoption of the new 2007 Compatibility Plan. The new Compatibility Plan is comprised of the 2004 Compatibility Plan, and may include one or more of the proposed Mitigation Measures described in the Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration.

The Compatibility Plan establishes policies for determining consistency between development projects within the Airport Influence Area, and the objectives set forth in the State Aeronautics Act (Pub. Util. Code §§21670-21679.5). Those objectives call for the Commission to protect public health, safety, and welfare by ensuring the orderly expansion of airports and the adoption of land use measures that minimize the public's exposure to excessive noise and safety hazards within areas around public airports to the extent that these areas are not already devoted to incompatible uses. (Pub. Util. Code §21670, subd. (a)(2).)
